Instructions for use on Trees, Shrubs, Vegetables, Flowers and Lawns:

LAWNS: 1 qt. to 10 gal. water covers 250-300 sq.ft. Feed lawns 3 times a year.

FLOWERS: 1 tbs. per gal. water every 3 weeks during growing season.

VEGETABLES: 1 cup to 2 gal. water every 3 or 4 weeks during growing season.

SHRUBS: 1 tbs. to qt. of water, apply every 4 weeks.

TREES: Small, ½ pt. to 1 gal. water, twice a year.

TREES: Large, 1½ pt to 2 gal. water, twice a year.

How to Use **Liquid Fertrell 1**

For corn and row crops: **Fertrell 1** should be placed in the row, close to the seed, with a squeeze pump or other liquid applicator, at the rate of 2 gallons per acre.

For tomatoes or other transplanting: **Fertrell 1** is best applied in the transplanting water, at the rate of 3 gallons per acre.

Fertrell 1 can be used as an effective foliar feeding by diluting 1 to 2 gallons to 20 gallons of water and applying with 50-gallon nozzles.
